

## Evidence of Artistic Ability Architecture Guidance

All applicants for Architecture at ICRGU are required to submit evidence of artistic and creative ability. Students are required to prepare original work to include in the submission to the School of Architecture and Built Environment for assessment.

The evidence should comprise of no more than ten examples of a students own art or design work.

Evidence must include pencil sketches of different subject matters (i.e. people, fruit, flowers, building) however a variety of techniques (drawing, painting, collage, sculpture, printing, photography) would be welcomed.

Work that demonstrates the students ability to think in 3D, as well as examples of quick sketching (within a short time limit of no more than 15 minutes) is also valuable to understanding a students skill level.

### Alternative assessment

Applicants are also invited to undertake the ICRGU/RGU Evaluation exercise as their submission of artistic ability – further instructions can be found by visiting:

### Timeframe

ICRGU endeavor to have the evidence assessed by the appropriate school within 24-48 hours and will feedback directly once a decision has been made.

### Submission

Accepted formats include; jpeg, PDF, Dropbox link or images within a PowerPoint Presentation.

### Extended development course

Submitted artwork which does not meet entry to year one of the pathway, may be offered a short 3 week portfolio development course directly preceding the academic semester start date.
