

Evidence of Artistic Ability - Art and Design

All applicants are expected to show evidence of artistic ability and creative thinking to apply for the Art and Design pathway at ICRGU.

Students are required to prepare **original work** to include in the submission. Applicants are requested to submit around ten examples of their own art and design work.

Evidence should include, but is not limited to the following:

- Demonstrate experimentation. This can be basic sketches to show how your work changed and evolved, such as extracts from a sketch book.
- Provide a range of media and style - for example photography, paint, pencil drawing, charcoal, chalk, modelling or 3D work.
- Place your artwork in an order that shows your artistic growth and the development in your artistic style. Perhaps place your earliest work first to show how you have improved.
- What has influenced and inspired your style - add a description **in words** to explain your approach.

ICRGU endeavour to have your artwork assessed by the appropriate school at the university within 72 hours and will feedback directly once a decision has been made.

Accepted formats for the submission are; jpeg, PDF, a Dropbox link or images within a PowerPoint presentation.

Extended development course: Submitted artwork which does not meet entry to year 1 of the pathways, may be offered a 1 semester portfolio development course directly preceding the academic semester.
